


**RESOLUTION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF QUÉBEC**

**THAT** the National Assembly reiterate its position of 18 October 2006, 31 March 2009 and 4 November 2009, by demanding that the Canadian Firearms Registry be maintained in its entirety, including the registration of hunting weapons, and urge the Federal Members to vote in favour of the motion submitted to the House of Commons by the Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security in order to discontinue the examination of Bill C-391, An Act to amend the Criminal Code and the Firearms Act (repeal of long-gun registry).
