


RESOLUTION BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF QUÉBEC

THAT the National Assembly of Québec take great satisfaction in the contents of the royal proclamation officially announced today, which designates 28 July as the day commemorating *The Great Disturbance* and which acknowledges in its preamble the historic wrongdoings unnecessarily inflicted in the name of the British Crown upon the Acadian people during its deportation from 1755 to 1763;

THAT it also congratulate the Société nationale de l'Acadie, its partners and the Acadian people for the success of the steps they proudly took to obtain this acknowledgement.
